Silence. - The Depth of Quiet...

In a world that constantly demands noise, opinions, and reactions, St Francis chose something radically different: stillness before God. He understood that silence isn't empty; it's where truth becomes clear and the heart is reshaped.

St Francis didn't just value silence, he depended on it. Before he preached, before he acted, before he made decisions, he listened. And in that listening, he discovered a deeper voice of God that doesn't compete, but waits.

We often fill every gap in our day with sound: music, scrolling, conversation, yet feel restless underneath it all. Silence can feel uncomfortable at first because it strips away distraction. But that's exactly where transformation begins.

Try this:

* Step away from noise for even 5-10 minutes today, no phone, no music.

* Sit in stillness and simply become aware of God's presence.

* When thoughts come, don't fight them, just return to quiet.

* Let silence teach you what truly matters.

St Francis shows us that silence isn't about withdrawing from life, it's about entering it more deeply, with clarity, peace, and purpose.

Sometimes, the most powerful thing you can say... is nothing at all

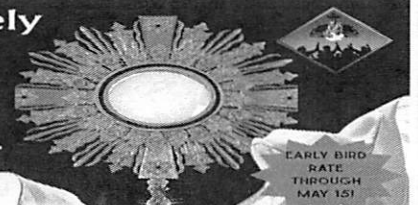
