t. Gertrude's Vacation Bible School (VBS) was a great success this summer. The program ran from June 12—16, 2023, and approximately 88 children were in attendance each day. The theme for this year was: *I AM God's Army*.

Each day began with registration and assembly at 9:00 a.m. for prayer and song. Prayers were then followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States and the New Mexico state flag.

Sessions included: Crafts, Music & Dance, Games, Storytelling, and Chapel with time for snacks. Classes were divided into Pre K-lst; 2nd-3rd, 4th-5th, and 6th-7th grades.

Father Paul Grala worked with lots of Parish volunteers to teach students the importance of faith, family, and friendship in our rapidly changing world.

Throughout the five days, emphasis was placed on the younger students learning basic prayers, i.e., the Sign of the Cross, the Glory Be, and the Guardian Angel Prayer. If they didn't know it, older students learned the St. Michael the Archangel Prayer.

The importance of attendance at Sunday Mass, reverence while in church, and living their Catholic faith was emphasized in all of their activities.

Craft projects included the following: coloring and decorating Guardian Angels and St. Michael the Archangel, followed by a different project each day. Armylike helmets were decorated, as were shields of armor with angel wings, prayers, American flags, and the Ten Commandments. Swords were fashioned, out of foam core, stenciled with a single angel feather, and students embellished their project to represent the Sword of the Spirit. The classes learned about Ioan of Arc and how, despite her young age, she was one of God's great warriors.


