Men's Group: Men's group meets the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of every month in the Chapel at 7pm.

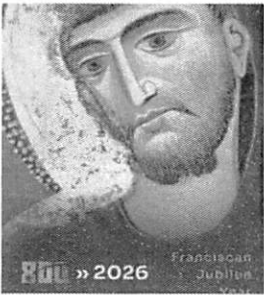
