St. Francis didn't just admire the idea of a new life, he chose it. And that choice began with repentance. Repentance is often misunderstood. It's not just feeling sorry or looking back with regret. It is the courage to take responsibility. To stop blaming circumstances, other people, or even our past and to finally say, "The change starts with me."

St Francis didn't wait for perfect conditions. He didn't say, "I'll follow God when things are easier." He recognized that the real obstacle wasn't outside of him, it was within. And instead of running from that truth, he embraced it. That is repentance: a turning of the heart, a decision to walk in a new direction.

Taking responsibility is not heavy when it's rooted in grace. It becomes freeing. Because the moment you own your life, you also open it to transformation. You stop being a victim of your story and become a participant in God's work within you.

Repentance is not about shame. It's about alignment. It's about returning to who you were created to be.

» Own it fast, no excuses

» Pause before reacting

» Fix one small thing daily

» Say sorry quickly

» Choose less comfort

» Do the right thing



If you want a different life, don't wait for everything around you to change. Start by turning your heart. Take responsibility. And trust that even the smallest step back toward God can begin a completely new path.

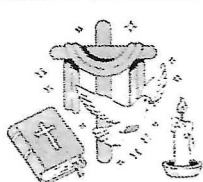
